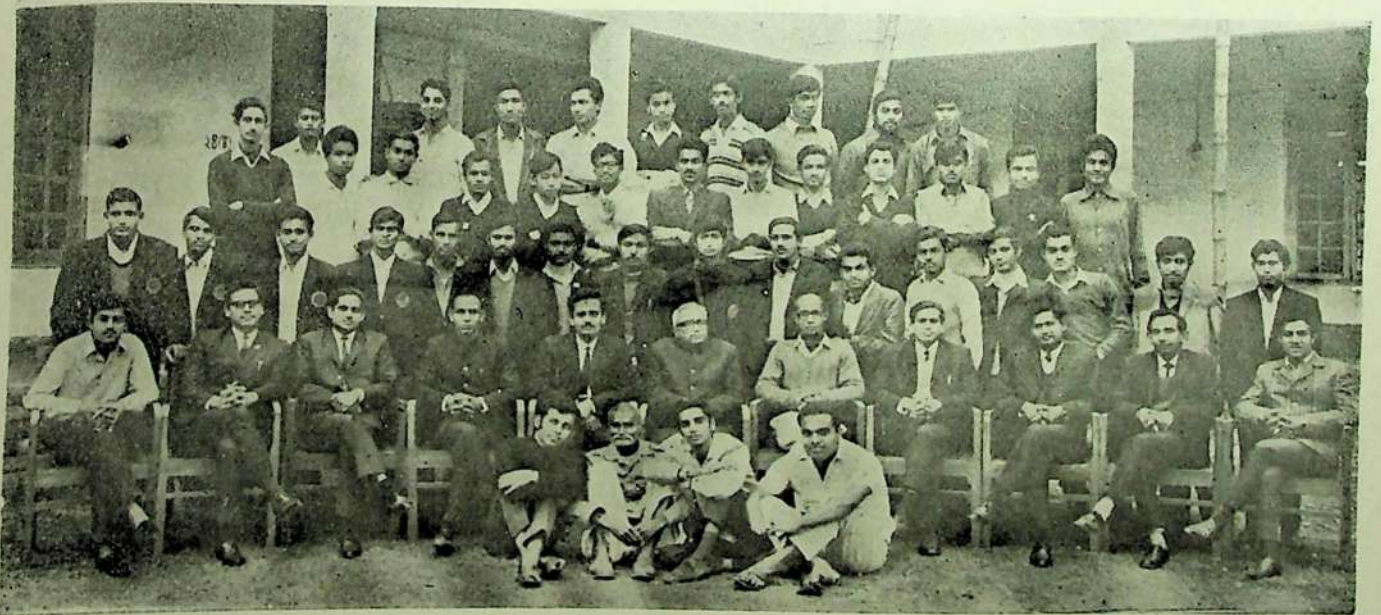
Life is a challenge—Meet it

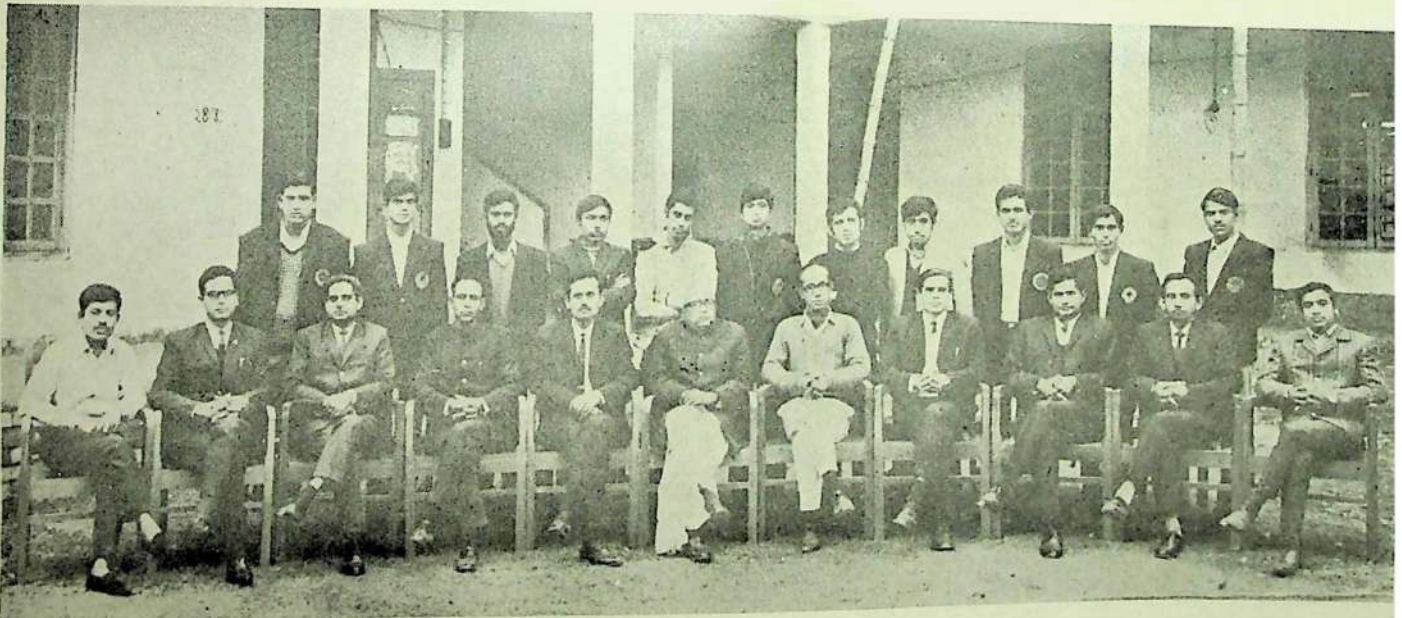
This year some of our athlets had shown a bit improved standard in both
